MONTHLY REPORT ON THE BOOT AND SHOE PRODUCTION OF CANADA,
JUNE, 1927.

The statistics of production of the leather boot and shoe industry of Canada for the month of June, 1927, are based on the returns of 175 factories out of a total of 180 factories in operation during the month. Four factories in Quebec and 1 factory in Ontario failed to make return. The factories in operation are located by \neq provinces as follows: Nova Scotia, 3; New Brunswick, 5; Quebec, 105; Ontario, 59; Manitoba, 1; Alberta, 1; and Tritish Columbia, 6.

The production of footwear during the month totalled 1,612,791 pairs, an inincrease over the preceding month of 8,905 pairs. Boots and shoes with leather or fabric
uppers totalled 1,475,493 pairs, a decrease from month of May of 4,516 pairs. Shoepacks, larrigans and moccasins, and footwear with/uppers show substantial increases,
while a decrease is shown in the production of slippers. The quantity of shoes made in
sizes for men was 486,348 pairs, an increase over the preceding month of 63,139 pairs.

Decreased production is recorded in the quantities of footwear mode in sizes for boys
and youths, women, misses and children and babies and infants. The classification
according to process shows increases for "welts", "turns" and "nailed, pegged, screw or
wire fastened", and decreases for "McKays and imitation welts" and "stitchdowns.".

A comparison of the statistics of production of boots and shoes with leather or fabric uppers for the month of June, 1927, with those for June, 1926, shows an increase of 16,421 pairs. Increases are r corded in boots and shoes made in sizes for men and for misses and children, while decreases are shown for the other classifications. Comparison with the statistics of 1926 can be made only for boots and shoes with leather or fabric uppers, as the monthly census of 1926 did not include an inquiry relating to the production of shoepacks, larrigans, Indian slippers and moccasins.

The cumulative production of footwear for the six months ended June 30, 1927, pairs, was 9,489,17 / an average per month of 1,581,519 pairs. The cumulative production of boots and shoes with leather or fabric uppers was 3,847,761 pairs, an average per month of 1,474,627 pairs, compared with a total of 2,446,445 pairs and an average of 1,407,741 pairs per month for the corresponding period of 1926.

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
