MONTHLY REPORT ON THE BOOT AND SHOE PRODUCTION OF CANADA, JULY, 1927

The statistics of the production of leather boots and shoes for the month of July, 1927, are based on the returns of 173 factories out of a total of 180 factories in operation during the month. Five factories in Quebec and 1 factory each in Ontario and British Columbia failed to make return. The distribution of the factorios in operation by provinces is as follows: Nova Scotia, 2; New Brunswick, 5; Quobec, 106; Ontario, 59; Manitoba, 1; Alberta, 1; and British Columbia, 6. The total output for the month, comprising boots and shoes with leather or fabric uppers, shoopacks, larrigans and moccasins, footwear with felt uppers, and cloth, carpot, boudoir and Indian slippors, was 1,503,578 pairs, a docrease from the preceding month of 109,213 pairs. The production of boots and shows with leather or fabric uppers was 1,344,232 pairs, a decrease from the preceding month of 131,261 pairs and a decrease from the month of July, 1926, of 140,993 pairs. The production of men's shees shows an increase compared with the proceeding menth, while all of the other classifications according to size show decreases. The classification by process of manufacture, shows an increase in the production of welts and decreased production for the other kinds. Increases are shown for shoopacks, larrigans and moccasins, footwear with felt uppers, and slippors.

The cumulative production of boots and shoes with leather or fabric uppers for the 7 months ending July 31, 1927, was 10,191,993 pairs, or an average per month of 1,455,999 pairs, compared with a total for the corresponding period of 1926 of 9,931,670 pairs and an average per month of 1,418,810 pairs.


