

REPORT ON THE PRODUCTION OF BOOTS AND SHOES IN CANADA, BIBLIOTHEQUE SEPTEMBER, 1927.

The statistics of boot and shoe production for the month of September are based on the returns of 170 factories out of a total of 177 factories in operation during the month. Four factories in Quebec and 3 in Ontario failed to make returns. The factories in operation are located by provinces as follows: Nova Scotia, 2; New Brunswick, 5; Quebec, 105; Ontario, 58; Manitoba, 1; Alberta, 1; and British Columbia, 5. The production of leather and felt footwear during the month totalled 1,719,693 pairs, a decrease from the preceding month of 135,695 pairs, or 7½ per cent. Boots and shoes with leather or fabric uppers totalled 1,548,559 pairs, a decrease from the preceding month of 127,009 pairs, or 3 per cent, but an increase over the corresponding month in 1926 of 14,446 pairs, or 1 per cent. Shoepacks, larrigans and moccasins and slippers show decreases from the month of August, while footwear with felt uppers shows an increase in production of 5,025 pairs. The decrease in total production is evenly divided between the different classifications of size and of process of manufacture.

The cumulative production of boots and shoes with leather or fabric uppers for the 9 months ended September 30, 1927, was 13,416,180 pairs, an increase over the cumulative production for the corresponding period of 1926 of 543,639 pairs. Neturns of larrigans, shoepacks, moccasins and Indian slippers were not included in the monthly consus of 1926, so that comparison cannot be made for all footwear for the 9 months period. The cumulative production of footwear for the 9 months ended September 30, 1927, was 14,567,775 pairs, an average per month of 1,613,642 pairs. The total production of footwear for the 12 months of 1926, according to the final report on the boot and shoe industry of Canada for that year was 19,396,539 pairs, or an average per month of 1,653,045 pairs. The average production per month for the first 9 months of 1927 was lower therefore than the average for the 12 months of 1926 by 39,403 pairs. It should be noted, however, that the final report for 1926 includes returns for all establishments, whereas the monthly reports lack on an average the returns for 5 or 6 factories.
