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REPORT ON THE PRODUCTION OF BOOTS AND SHOES IN CANADA, AUGUST, 1928.

Number of Factories.— The statistics of footwear production for the month of August, 1928, are based on the returns of 178 factories out of a total of 185 factories in operation during the month. The factories in operation are located by provinces as follows: Nova Scotia, 4; New Brunswick, 3; Quebec, 111; Ontario, 59; Manitoba, 2; and British Columbia, 6. Six factories in Quebec and 1 factory in Ontario failed to make return.

Production.- The production of footwear during the month of August, 1928, amounted to 1,829,964 pairs, an increase over the preceding month of 197,088 pairs or 12 p.c., but a decrease from the month of August, 1927, of 25,427 pairs or 1 p.c. The production for August, 1928, comprised 556,285 pairs of footwear in sizes for men, 123,827 pairs in sizes for boys and youths, 832,844 pairs for women, 202,303 pairs for misses and children, and 114,205 pairs in sizes for babies and infants. All of these classifications show increases over the preceding month excepting footwear for misses and children, which showed a decrease. The relative position of each of these classifications with regard to total production for the month of August is as follows: footwear for women, 46 p.c.; for men, 30 p.c., for misses and children, 11 p.c.; for boys and youths, 7 p.c.; and for babies and infants, 6 p.c.

Cumulative Production. The cumulative production of footwear for the 8 months ended August 31st, 1925, was 13,706,937 pairs, or an average per month of 1,713,367 pairs, in comparison with a total of 12,848,082 pairs and an average per month of 1,606,010 pairs for the corresponding period of 1927.

Average Production per Factory. The average output per factory in August, 1928, was 10,281 pairs, compared with 9,774 pairs in the preceding month and 10,663 pairs in the month of August, 1927.

Imports and Exports.— The imports of footwear with leather uppers in August, 1928, amounted to 91,954 pairs, compared with 62,032 pairs in July. The quantity of Canadian-made leather footwear exported in August, 1928, was 10,327 pairs, compared with 11,545 pairs in the preceding month. The trade in leather footwear is chiefly with the United Kingdom and the United States.


