2Tumber of Factooies.- The firures of leatier footwcar production for the monts of Naw, 1930, are based on the returns of lig factories out of a total of 173 factoiles in operation durine the month. Three factories in ouebec and one factory in Ontario criled to make retum. The factoris in overation during tie nonth are locsted by provinces as follows: Yova Scotia, 2; Yew 3runswic', 4; 2webec, 102; Ontar10, 58; Manitojo, 1 ; and 3ritish Colurnbia, 6.

Froduction.- Canada's production of leatier footwear in "ay, 1 30, amounted to $1,524,038$ paiss, compared witil $1,574,405$ nairs in tie weceding montin and $1,538,350$ pairs in the nontin of \%ay, 192. Tootwear for women accounted for 45 ner cent of the total output of Yay, 1930, and footwear for men 26 per cent, the remainins: 28 per cent beins diviled between lootwear for boys and youths, misses and children, and babies and infants. The total output $\hat{x}$ or vay is made un as follows: boots and sioes witi leather of fabric uppers, $1,370,781$ pairs; shoepacks, larrisans and moccasins, 10,977 pairs; footwear with felt unners, 63,355 pairs; and slippers of all inds, 79,825 pairs. The first classification shows a decrease compared with the preceding montit, wille all of the otizer classifications show increases.

Cumlative Production.- Produciion of leatici footwear for tize five montins ended Yay 31, 1930, anounted to $7,374,139$ pairs, on an avera;e ner montin of $1,474,828$ pairs, compared with a total of $7,369,638$ pairs and an avernce of $1,593,028$ pairs for the coraespondina neriot of 152 .

Imports and Expoits. - The quantity of boots and stoos with Ieatier uppers imponted into Canada durin: the month of "ay, 1030, was 102,360 pairs, compared with 89,292 pairs in Auril and 76,360 pairs in Mar, 1929. These noods came chiefly from tine United Fingdom, the United States and Czecho-Slovalia, tie imports from the United Zingaom anounting to 25 per cent of the total, fam tie Jritea States to 48 ner cent, and Irom Czecio-Slovalia to 25 per cent. The imports of boots and shoes with canvas unners amounted to 2,04 nairs in "ar, comared wits 4,545 pairs in the preceding month and 3.027 nairs in $\mathrm{Na}, 122$, and the imorts of boots and swes with ?elt uppers to 42 pairs, compared witi 33 vairs in Anil and 721 pairs in a", l020. 300ts and shoes With canvas upners come chicily İora tie Jnited States, and ritin felt unpers from the Trited Tingdom and the mited States.
