THE LEATHER BOOT AND SHOE INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1924

PRODUCTION: The total number of pairs of leather footwear, comprising boots, shoes and slippers, manufactured during the year was 17,729,421, a decrease from 1923 of 394,473 pairs, or 2 per cent, but an increase over the year 1922 of 535,215 pairs, or 3 per cent. Boots and shoes classified as "men's", "boys'" and "ladies'" show decreases in quantity of output, compared with 1923, while those classified as "youths'", "misses'" and "girls'" show increases. The output of slippers classified as "men's, boys' and youths'" shows a decrease in quantity, while that of "ladies', misses' and girls'" shows an increase. The total value of production in 1924 was \$42,003,563, compared with \$45,596,012 in 1923 and \$45,503,858 in 1922. Average selling values of all classes of boots and shoes, except misses', were lower in 1924 than in 1923, while average selling values of slippers were higher. The following table gives comparative statistics of quantity and value of product for 1924 and the two preceding years.

LEATHER BOOT AND SHOE INDUSTRY - CANADA.

ESTABLISHMENTS: The number of establishments making leather footwear in Canada in 1924 was 183, compared with 186 in 1923 and 181 in 1922. The following statement shows the number of establishments, by provinces, in each of the three years:

Included with the above totals are 7 establishments in 1922 and 1923 and 5 establishments in 1924, engaged in the manufacture of boots and shoes with felt uppers.

CAPITAL: The total value of the capital investment in 1924 was \$30,835,479, apportioned as follows: \$12,539,101, the value of the land, buildings and machinery; \$9,445,193, the value of materials, supplies and finished products on hand, stocks in process, etc.; and \$8,851,185, the cash and trading and operating accounts. Compared with the preceding year an increase of \$301,883 is shown in the total value of capital.

EMPLOYEES AND SALARIES AND WAGES: The number of wage-earners in 1924 was 12,921 and the number of salaried employees, 1,304, a total of 14,225 employees, compared with 12,439 wage-earners, 1,664 salaried employees, and a total of 14,043 in 1923. The total amount paid to employees in 1924 was \$13,772,451, comprising \$11,007,392 to wage-earners and \$2,765,059 to salaried employees. The amounts in 1923 were: \$10,491,321 to wage-earners; \$3,460,123 to salaried employees; total, \$13,951,444. The number of persons employed in 1924 shows an increase over the preceding year of 182, while the total amount paid in salaries and wages shows a decrease of \$178,993. The industry also gave employment in 1924 to 283 outside piece-workers, with payments totalling \$40,863. Comparative figures for 1923 are: 348 outside pieceworkers, and \$76,407, the amount paid.

MATERIALS USED: The total cost value of materials used was \$21,667,083, itemized as follows: \$10,816,104, the value of upper materials; \$7,034,222, the value of bottom materials, and \$3,816,757, the value of findings and miscellaneous materials. Compared with the preceding year a decrease of \$1,026,128 is shown in the total cost value.

IMPORTS AND EXPORTS

The total value of footwear (except rubber) imported into Canada for consumption during the 12 months ended March 31, 1925 was \$2,111,083, of which footwear to the value of \$1,217,234 came from the United Kingdom; \$823,809 from the United States; and \$70,040 from other countries. The total value of imports shows an increase of \$137,570 compared with the preceding fiscal year. The value of foot-exported amounted to \$329,348, compared with \$304,913 in the fiscal year 1924. The exports to the United Kingdom shows an increase, while the export to the United States shows a decrease.

GENERAL TABLES

Detailed statistics of the leather boot and shoe industry, by provinces, and statistics of imports and exports, by countries, are given in the general tables. A list of the boot and shoe establishments is issued as an appendix to the report. The volume also contains a report giving summary statistics of the boot and shoe findings (leather) industry.

BOOT AND SHOE FINDINGS, LEATHER, CANADA

The number of establishments engaged in the manufacture of leather boot and shoe findings in Canada in 1924 was 14, located by provinces as follows: Quebec 8; Ontario 6. The principal items of manufacture were counters, leather board, soles and heels. The total value of production in 1924 was \$1,276,114, compared with \$1,277,337 in the preceding year. The following tables show (1) the principal statistics of the industry, and (2) production by kind and value.
