

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

THE LEATHER FOOTWEAR INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1938.

The Canadian leather footwear industry produces footwear of all grades, ranging from the finest of kid to the heaviest of leather, and has an annual output of many millions of pairs. The high record to date is held by the year 1937, when 24,325,355 pairs were manufactured.

In 1938 the production amounted to 21,977,600 pairs, or 2,347,755 pairs less than the record year 1937. Footwear made in sizes for women is of first importance, the pairage of this group representing 46 per cent of the total production. Next, in order of quantity, comes footwear for men, with 30 per cent, and following are footwear for misses and children with 14 per cent; footwear for boys and youths, with 6 per cent; and footwear for babies and infants, with 4 per cent.

The total value of output of the industry in 1938 was \$37,194,770 compared with \$41,088,713 in 1937. Quebec and Ontario, together, account for 97 per cent of the total value of output, the production of the former province representing 60 per cent and of the latter, 37 per cent.

The following table shows quantity and value of footwear manufactured in the years 1937 and 1938, by classification of purpose, while in Table II will be found the pairage and the average price per pair in the years 1921 to 1938, and in Table III the principal statistics of the industry from 1924 to 1938.

## THE LEATHER FOOTWEAR INDUSTRY, CANADA

### FOREIGN TRADE

**Exports.** - The exports of Canadian-made leather footwear in 1938 totalled 350,754 pairs, valued at \$784,435, compared with a pairage of 355,300 and a value of \$815,974 in the preceding year. The United Kingdom, Jamaica and New Zealand share the bulk of the exports.

**Imports.** - Leather footwear was imported into Canada in 1938 to the value of \$1,169,052, covering 748,313 pairs. These totals include the following items: boots, shoes and slippers with leather uppers, 588,574 pairs, value \$1,103,929; boots and shoes, pegged or wire fastened, with unstitched soles, close edged, 5,957 pairs, value \$8,061; and boots and shoes with felt uppers, 153,782 pairs, value \$57,062. Compared with the preceding year the total quantity shows an increase of 68,847 pairs, and the value an increase of \$157,688. Of the total value of the Canadian imports of leather footwear, goods from the United States accounted for 55 per cent, and from the United Kingdom, for 31 per cent. The remaining 14 per cent is covered by imports from various other countries, combined. The imports mentioned in this paragraph are exclusive of boots and shoes (kind and pairage unspecified) imported by tourists under the \$100 exemption privilege.
