# THE LEATHER GLOVE AND MITTEN INDUSTRY

## 1956

Factory shipments of the Leather Glove and Mitten Industry in 1956 were valued at \$11,737,959, an increase of almost 22 p.c. over the \$9,628,042 reported for 1955. Inventories of finished goods and goods in process increased in value by a total of \$229,881, as shown in Table II, indicating an apparent production valued at \$11,967,840. Cost of materials used was \$5,991,660 (\$5,039,888), an increase of nearly 19 p.c. while the cost of fuel and electricity fell slightly to \$69,952 from \$71,461 in 1955. Value added by manufacture increased almost 33 p.c. to \$5,906,228. The number of employees

and salaries and wages paid were up 8.5 p.c. and 16.0 p.c., respectively.

The value of leather gloves and mittens imported into Canada in 1956 was \$1,289,067, an increase of 13.2 p.c. over the previous year. The United Kingdom and France remained the chief sources of supply. Women's kid gloves, chiefly from France, accounted for 27 p.c. of the total imports. Exports of Canadian made gloves amounted to \$190,201, an increase of 26 p.c. over the previous year.


