THE LEATHER GLOVE AND MITTEN INDUSTRY

1957

Factory Shipments of the Leather Glove and Mitten Industry in 1957 were valued at \$11,115,134, a decrease of 5.3 p.c. from the \$11,737,959 reported for 1956. Inventories of finished goods and of goods in process increased in value by a total of \$300,142 as shown in Table 11, indicating an apparent production valued at \$11,415,276. Cost of materials used was \$5,712,955 (\$5,991,660), a decrease of 4.6 p.c. while the cost of fuel and electricity increased to \$77,932 (\$69,952). Employment was down slightly at 1813 (1857) but salaries and wages paid were up 3.6 p.c. to \$3,755,835 (\$3,625,203). Value

added by manufacture decreased 4.7 p.c. to \$5,624,389 (\$5,906,228).

The value of leather gloves and mittens imported into Canada in 1957 was \$1,370,097, an increase of 6.2 p.c. over the previous year. As usual, the United Kingdom and France were the chief sources of supply. Women's kid gloves, chiefly from France, accounted for 26 p.c. of the total imports. Exports of Canadian made gloves suffered a relatively serious decline to \$68,388, (\$190,201).


