

NOTICE

THE MISCELLANEOUS LEATHER PRODUCTS INDUSTRY

1951

The gross value of production of the Miscellaneous Leather Products Industry in 1951 was recorded as \$24,395,172, a decrease of 6.5 p.c. from the high point of \$26,101,958 recorded for 1950.

While some commodities were produced in greater volume, including such items as double harness, saddles, custom-built luggage, brief-cases and fabric shopping bags, most items were produced in smaller numbers. Important items registering a lower volume of production included trunks, hand luggage and handbags and these, together with other commodities, accounted for the lower total value of production. The average prices of most articles were higher than in 1950 but those of custom-built luggage and fabric handbags and shopping bags were lower than in that year. The relative cost of materials was 48.2 p.c. of the total value of production in 1951, compared to 47.1 p.c. in 1950.

Employment was afforded 4,526 persons, a decrease of 12 p.c. from the previous year. There were 2,513 males and 2,013 females employed.

Ontario continued as the major producer, accounting for 49 p.c. of the total value of production; Quebec followed with 42 p.c. and the remaining eight provinces accounted for only 9 p.c.

The statistics shown in the present report relate only to the production of those establishments whose main output can be classified as "Miscellaneous Leather Products". Many of the commodities produced in this industry are also made in related industries and these items are foot-noted in the tables of production.

THE LEATHER BELTING INDUSTRY

1951

Firms classified under this industry are those whose chief item of manufacture is transmission belting of leather. The industry is confined to Quebec and Ontario, with 5 and 10 plants, respectively. The total value of production in 1951 was \$2,219,069, an increase of \$324,771, or 17.1 p.c. over the preceding year.

Production consisted of leather belting, welting, straps, leather washers and miscellaneous items. The value of output in Quebec was \$953,412 and in Ontario \$1,265,657.

Statistics of imports and exports of leather belting are given in Tables 10 and 11 of the Miscellaneous Leather Products section of this bulletin.
