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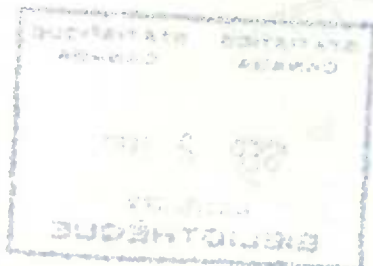

The first part of the report is devoted to a description of the data used in the analysis. The data are derived from the 1981 Census of Canada and are presented in Table 1. The second part of the report is devoted to a description of the methodology used in the analysis. The methodology is based on the use of the following variables: (1) the number of children in the household, (2) the number of children in the household who are under the age of 18, (3) the number of children in the household who are under the age of 14, (4) the number of children in the household who are under the age of 10, (5) the number of children in the household who are under the age of 6, (6) the number of children in the household who are under the age of 2, (7) the number of children in the household who are under the age of 1, (8) the number of children in the household who are under the age of 0. The third part of the report is devoted to a description of the results of the analysis. The results are presented in Table 2. The fourth part of the report is devoted to a description of the conclusions of the analysis. The conclusions are that the number of children in the household is a function of the number of children in the household who are under the age of 18, the number of children in the household who are under the age of 14, the number of children in the household who are under the age of 10, the number of children in the household who are under the age of 6, the number of children in the household who are under the age of 2, the number of children in the household who are under the age of 1, and the number of children in the household who are under the age of 0.
