REVENUE IN CANADA

Revenue in Canada has increased steadily since 1950. The total revenue in 1959 was \$2.1 billion, compared with \$1.2 billion in 1950. This represents an increase of 75% over the ten-year period. The increase is due to a combination of factors, including a rise in income tax revenue, a decline in excise tax revenue, and a steady increase in other revenue.
