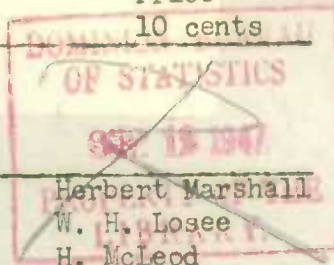

NAILS, TACKS AND STAPLESHistorical File CopyJULY, 1947

Production in Canada of iron and steel nails and staples, and of tacks of all kinds, was as follows during July, 1947: wire nails, 5,636 tons; cut nails, 66 tons; wire staples, 141 tons; and tacks, 143 tons.
