OMINANIZED SHEETS - OCTOBER, NOVEMBER, DECEMBER, 1934.

Production of galvanized sheets in Canada during the months of October, November and December, 1934, amounted to 9,567 tons as compared with 10,516 tons in the previous quarter and 9,105 tons in the last quarter of a year ago.

During the calendar year 1934 output totalled 39,403 tons as against corresponding totals of 32,859 tons in 1933 and 27,728 tons in 1932.
