GALVANIZED SHEFTS - THIRD QUARTER, 1935

Production of galvanized sheets in Canada at 13,366 tons during the third quarter of 1935 was the highest reported for any three-month period since the Bureau commenced collecting quarterly data on galvanized sheets in 1932. During April, May and June of this year production totalled 11,811 tons and for the third quarter of 1934 amounted to 10,516 tons.
