QUARTERLY REPORT

GALVANIZED SHEETS - APRIL, MAY AND JUNE, 1936.

Production of galvanized sheets in Canada during April, May and June of this year amounted to 15,396 tons, the greatest tonnage reported for any quarter-year period since quarterly records were commenced in 1932. For the first three months of this year the output was reported at 9,015 tons, bringing the half-year total to 24,411 tons compared with 17,684 tons and 19,320 tons in the corresponding periods of 1935 and 1934, respectively.

Imports of smooth galvanized sheets, strip, etc., totalled 5,032 tons valued at \$337,773 during the three months under review as against 1,461 tons at \$111,505 in the preceding quarter and 3,598 tons at \$239,516 during April, May and June of last year. Imports of corrugated sheets, coated or not, amounted to 78 tons valued at \$5,290 in the second quarter of this year compared with 95 tons at \$4,703 in the preceding three-month period.
