GALVANIZED SHEETS, 1931.

Production of galvanized sheets in Canada during October, November and December, 1931, amounted to 7,594 net tons to make a total output for the calendar year of 41,720 tons. Imports of galvanized sheets during the fourth quarter were reported at 3,433 tons, of which 2,593 tons came from Great Britain, 792 tons from the United States, and 48 tons from other countries. Imports for the year to date totalled 15,917 tons.
