STEEL WIRE

June, 1946

Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 10,171 tons during the month of June, 1946. This total included 6,613 tons of plain wire, 2,329 tons of galvanized wire, 317 tons of other coated wire, and 912 tons of barbed wire.
