STEEL WIREMAY, 1947.

Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 9,865 tons during the month of May, 1947. This total included 6,501 tons of plain wire, 2,163 tons of galvanized wire, 288 tons of other coated wire, and 913 tons of barbed wire.

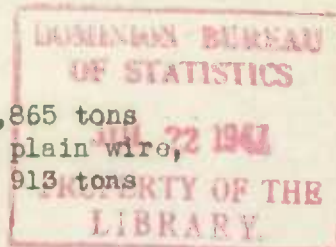
