Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 8,861 tons during the month of February, 1948. This total included 4,854 tons of plain wire, 2,179 tons of galvanized wire, 256 tons of other coated wire, 888 tons of barbed wire, 61 tons of cold rolled flat wire of all sizes, qualities and finishes, and 623 tons of welding rods and welding wire.
