STEEL WIRE - APRIL, 1948

Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 8,188 tons during the month of April, 1948. This total included 4,206 tons of plain wire, 2,190 tons of galvanized wire, 243 tons of other coated wire, 847 tons of barbed wire and 37 tons of cold rolled flat wire of all sizes, qualities and finishes.
