Shipments of Steel Wire by Canadian producers amounted to 10,628 tons during the month of March, 1949. This total included 6,457 tons of plain wire, 2,688 tons of galvanized wire, 228 tons of other coated wire, 1,139 tons of barbed wire, and 116 tons of cold rolled flat wire of all sizes.


