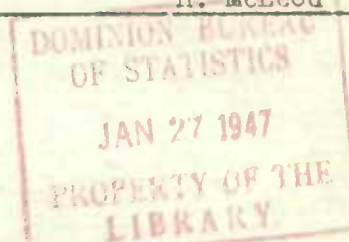

WIRE FENCING

November, 1946



Production in Canada of steel wire fencing totalled 1,239 tons during November, 1946, and included 1,137 tons of farm fencing and 99 tons of chain link fabric.
