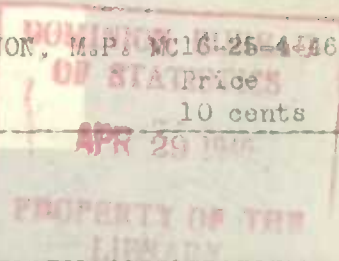

FEBRUARY - 1946

Production in Canada of steel wire fencing totalled 1,887 tons during the month of February, 1946 and included 1,749 tons of farm fencing; 13 tons of lawn fencing and 125 tons of woven chain link fabric.
