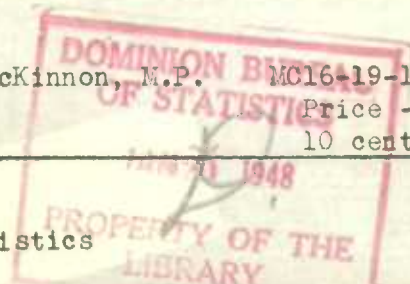

WIRE FENCINGNOVEMBER - 1947

Production in Canada of steel wire fencing totalled 2,369 tons during November, 1947, and included 2,322 tons of farm fencing and 47 tons of chain link fabric.
