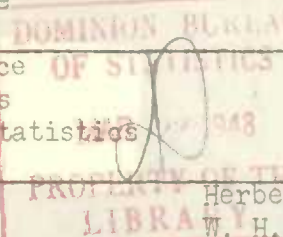

Historical File CopyWIRE FENCINGJANUARY, 1948

Production in Canada of steel wire fencing totalled 2,362 tons during January, 1948, and included 2,215 tons of farm fencing, 107 tons of woven wire lawn fencing, and 40 tons of chain link fabric.
