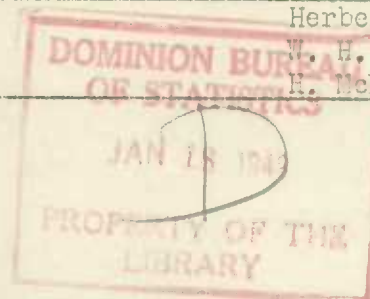

Production in Canada of steel wire fencing totalled 2,020 tons during November, 1948 and included 1,770 tons of farm fencing, 135 tons of lawn fencing and 115 tons of chain link fabric.
