A final analysis of the 1946 reports from the manufacturers of iron and steel and their products In Gaunda indicates a gross production valued at \$1,405,542,865 at factory prices. This output value was 28.5 per cent below the corresponding figure for 1945.

The values by industries for 1946 were as follows, in millions of dollars: pig iron, ferrolloys, theel and rolled products, \$153.1; iron castings \$82.3; heating and cooking apparatus \$35.9; boilers, tanks and platework \$26.7; farm implements \$63.2; machinery \$145.6; automobiles \$193.4; automobile parts \$93.4; bicycles \$3.7; aircraft \$36.2; shipbuilding \$91.8; railway rolling stock and parts 162.2; wire and wire goods \$40.1; sheet metal products \$115.7; hardware, cutlery and tools \$73.1; bridge and structural steel work \$40.1; machine shops \$20.5; and miscellaneous iron and steel products \$28.4.

The distribution of this production by provinces was as follows: Interio had \$879.2 millions; Quebec \$330.4; Nova Scotia \$42.0; Manitoba \$44.7; British Columbia \$77.9; New Brunswick \$14.9; Saakatchewan \$2.7; Alberta \$13.1; and Prince Edward Island \$0.6 millions.

In 1946 a total of 2,356 factories operated in this group. These works employed a monthly average of 249,279 people who were paid \$475.8 millions for salaries and wages. Materials used in manufacturing processes cost \$635.3 millions, and fuel and electricity cost \$34.7 millions.
