ANNUAL COMMODITY BULLETIN

OIL BURNERS, 1935.

According to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa, 5,607 oil burners were produced in Canada during 1935. Of this total 4,442 were gravity feed atmospheric burners and 1,165 were power burners for domestic and commercial use. Sales of oil burners by the producers were reported at 5,446 atmospheric burners with a factory selling price of \$113,858 and 1,184 power burners at \$167,525.

On December 31, 1935, the manufacturers reported stocks on hand of 752 atmospheric and 360 power burners.

Import figures do not show oil burners separately but for 1935 an item totalling 12,512 units valued at \$181,331 appears under the heading "Apparatus designed for cooking or for heating buildings, for oil."
