ANNUAL COMMODITY BULLETIN

STEEL WIRE - 1935.

Factory sales of steel wire by Canadian producers were valued at \$4,372,393 in 1935, an improvement of 21 per cent over the \$3,617,756 reported for the previous year. Sales during 1935 included 36,096 net tons of plain wire, 20,104 tons of galvanized wire, 12,707 tons of barbed wire and 3,423 tons of coated wire other than galvanized. Inventories on December 31, 1935, amounted to 5,273 tons of plain wire, 3,601 tons of barbed wire, 2,117 tons of galvanized wire, and 469 tons of other coated wire.
