

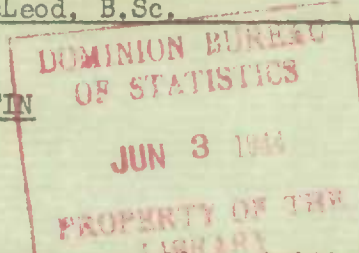

STEEL WIRE, 1939



Factory sales of steel wire by Canadian producers totalled 89,942 tons valued at \$6,751,215 at factory prices in 1939 compared with 69,060 tons valued at \$5,124,613 in 1938. This year's sales included 47,754 tons of plain wire at \$3,418,026, 23,093 tons of galvanized wire at \$1,801,609, 3,995 tons of other coated wire at \$451,114, and 15,100 tons of barbed wire at \$1,080,466.
