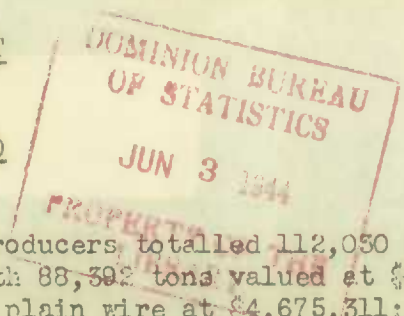


STEEL WIRE - 1940



Factory sales of steel wire by Canadian producers totalled 112,030 tons valued at \$9,267,927 at factory prices in 1940 compared with 88,392 tons valued at \$6,591,454 in 1939. This year's sales included 60,306 tons of plain wire at \$4,675,311; 34,070 tons of galvanized wire at \$3,031,744; 4,743 tons of other coated wire at \$577,241, and 12,911 tons of barbed wire at \$983,631.
