STEEL WIRE - 1941

Factory sales of steel wire by Canadian producers totalled 113,043 tons valued at \$9,430,118 at factory prices in 1941 compared with 112,135 tons valued at \$9,215,079 in 1940. This year's sales included 63,734 tons of plain wire at \$5,057,922; 26,352 tons of galvanized wire at \$2,453,744; 5,586 tons of other coated wire at \$648,196 and 17,371 tons of barbed wire at \$1,270,256.
