Factory sales of steel wire by Canadian producers totalled 35,286 (tons valued at \$7,492,010 at factory prices in 1942 compared with 113,043 tons valued at \$9,430,118 in 1941. This year's sales included 53,218 tons of wire drawn from rode valued at \$4,517,172; 21,092 tons of galvanized wire at \$2,082,878, and 10,975 tons of barbed wire at \$891,960.
