STOVES, 1933

Production in Canada of cook stoves and ranges, heating stoves, electric rangettes and electric and gas cooking plates amounted in value to \$4,634,939 at factory prices in 1933. In 1932 the corresponding value was \$4,685,388 and in 1931 it was \$6,979,497.

Output in 1933 included 59,068 coal and wood cook stoves and ranges, 16,490 gas cook stoves and ranges, 15,445 electric cook stoves and ranges, 29,599 coal and wood heating stoves, 3,537 combinations for gas and coal, 887 combinations for coal and electric, 29,201 electric cooking plates and grills, 4,771 gas cooking plates and 1,663 electric rangettes.

In 1933, stoves and cooking plates and grills were produced in 53 different establishments of which 32 were in Ontario, 9 in Quebec, 4 in Nova Scotia, 3 in New Brunswick, 3 in British Columbia and 2 in Manitoba. Production in Ontario amounted to \$3,504,693, in Quebec to \$684,637, in the Maritimes to \$417,502 and in the western provinces to \$28,107.
