STOVES - 1946

Production of cooking and heating stoves in Canada during 1946 was valued at \$19,322,736 (factory selling prices) compared with \$12,770,198 in 1945 and \$9,654,750 in 1944.

Sixty-three factories in Canada made stoves, plates or grills in 1946, including 30 in Ontario; 11 in Quebec; 5 in British Columbia; 6 in Manitoba; 4 in Nova Scotia; 3 in Alberta, and 4 in New Brunswick.
