WARM AIR FURNACES - 1947

Production of warm air furnaces in Canada during 1947 totalled 54,361 units with a factory selling value of \$5,818,263. In 1946 the output amounted to 45,482 units with a factory selling value of \$4,139,125. Of the 54,361 furnaces made during 1947, the factories in Ontario accounted for 38,138; British Columbia, 5,437; New Brunswick, 4,536; Quebec, 2,296; Nova Scotia, 392 and the Prairie Provinces, 3,562.

Fifty-five plants reported a production of warm air furnaces during 1947, there being 26 in Ontario, 9 in British Columbia, 3 in Nova Scotia, 4 in New Brunswick, 5 in Quebec, 3 in Manitoba, 4 in Alberta and 1 in Saskatchewan.
