

AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

CANADA PRODUCED 124,878 AUTOMOBILES IN FIRST HALF, 1926

June 1926

Following the record output of May Canada's production of automobiles dropped slightly to 21.751 units in June, 1926. This output included 6,610 open passenger cars, 11.175 closed models. 2.586 trucks, 1,354 chassis and 26 taxicabs or buses and compares with a total production of 24,934 in May, 21,502 in April and 15,420 in June of last year.

During the month under review the production of passenger cars numbered 17,785 as against 21,095 in the previous month and 12,638 in June of a year ago. Closed car models dropped slightly in number to 11,175 from 12,327 in May but was almost double the output of 5,653 units in June, 1925. Open car models at 6,610 was 25 per cent below the 8,768 units produced in the preceding month and slightly below the 6,985 units reported for June of a year ago. Trucks at 2,586 showed a drop of 15 per cent from 3,037 in May and compares with an output of 1,706 in the corresponding month of last year. The 1,354 chassis produced in June was almost double the 787 of May.

For the first half of 1926 the cumulative production was 33 per cent above the number made during the same period of 1925 and the value of the cars made, based on selling price f.o.b. plant, was about sixteen million dollars or 27 per cent over the selling value of the cars produced in the first six months of last year. This year's output to date included 44,880 open model passenger cars, 51,066 closed passenger cars, 15,973 trucks, 12,860 chassis and 99 taxicabs or buses.

Motor car imports for June amounted to 4,904 and with the production of 21,751 made a total supply of 26,655 cars available for use in Canada, but as 4,584 were exported in the same month the apparent consumption was 22,071 as against 10,931 in the corresponding month of last year. For the first six months of this year production totalled 124,878 and 16,604 were imported to make an available supply of 141,482, but as exports amounted to 38,833 the apparent consumption of motor cars in Canada for the first half of 1926 amounted to 102,649 units as compared with 65,255 during the first six months of 1925.

In the United States the June production of motor cars was 383,575 of which 339,542 were passenger cars and 44,033 were trucks, as compared with 420,978 passenger cars and trucks in May and 388,619 in June, 1925.
