

### AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

SEPTEMBER AUTOMORILE PRODUCTION IN CANADA WAS 11 PER CENT GREATEN THAN IN AUGUST

#### September 1926

September production in Canada of 16,953 automobiles marked an increase of 11 per cent over the 15,261 machines produced in August, and an advance of 32 per cent over the total of 12,804 reported for September, 1925. Although the output of passenger cars declined in number to 12,150 from 12,448 in the previous month, this loss was more than offset by an increased production of trucks and chassis. The number of trucks made in September was 3,250 as compared with 2.079 in August, and chassis numbered 1,535 as against 725 in the next preceding month.

Jomparison of this month's output with the production in September, 1925, showed 4,874 open passenger cars as against 4,886; the autput of closed models rose to 7,276 from 3,988; trucks also advanced to 3,250 from 2,254 and the production of chassis fell off slightly to 1,535 from 1,664 in September a year ago. September output had a total sales value f.o.b. plant of \$10,905,447 in 1926 as against \$9,164,258 in 1925.

For the first nine months of the present year, the cumulative production was 172,300 cars, trucks and chassis valued at \$105,560,838, f.o.b. plant an increase of 35 per cent in number and 27 per cent in salling value over the output of 127,454 units valued at \$83,137,288 during the corresponding period last year.

During the month under review Canadian production totalled 16,953 cars, imports into Canada amounted to 2,258 making an available supply of 19,211 cars but as 6,501 were experted, the apparent consumption during September amounted to 12,710. For the year to date the apparent consumption totalled 14,95 units as against 69,257 units in the corresponding period of 1923.

In the United States the September production fell off 3 per cent to 350,811 from 380,258 in August but the nine months' output of 3,118,461 was 10 per cent over the 2,695,057 produced in the first three quarters of last year.
