Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 25,921 units in December, 1949 compared with 19,7?1 units in the previous month and with 27,305 units in December, 1948. The shipments for the current month included 18,531 passenger cars, 7,366 trucks and 24 buses.
