



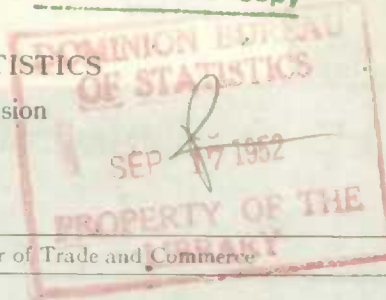

MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTSJULY - 1952

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 34,314 units in July, 1952 compared with 41,110 units in the previous month and with 30,294 units in July, 1951. The shipments for the current month included 24,958 passenger cars, 9,318 trucks and 38 buses.
