

AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

October 1927

Production of automobiles in Canada during October numbered 7,791 cars. This output was the lowest reported for the year to date, and was 31 per cent less than the 11,262 cars made in the previous month and 47 per cent below the output of 14,670 cars in October of a year ago. Lower production was reported for all models excepting trucks having a capacity of less than one ton and chassis for truck service which types increased in number to 49 from 25 and to 1,243 from 275, respectively.

In comparison with production in October last year, the output of open model passenger cars declined to 1,322 from 3,844; closed models dropped to 4,508 from 5,210; trucks to 280 from 2,874; chassis to 1,680 from 2,737, while only 1 bus was made as compared with 5 in October, 1926.

During October the apparent consumption of automobiles in Canada, as determined by adding the imports of 2,156 to the 4,632 cars produced for sale in Canada, amounted to 6,788 cars. For the year to date the apparent consumption thus computed amounted to 154,984 cars.

For the ten months ending October 31, 1927, production totalled 169,374 automobiles having a sales value, f. o. b. plant, of \$110,762,754. These totals marked a reduction of 10 per cent in number and 3 per cent in value from the figures for the corresponding period of last year when 187,536 cars valued at \$114,450,116 were produced in Canada. Production this year to date included 35,834 open passenger cars, 95,280 closed passenger cars, 21,444 trucks, 16,796 chassis and 20 taxicabs or buses.
