## MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS


## OCTOBER - 1950

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 35,573 units in October, 1950 compared with 38,035 units in the previous month and with 28,125 units in October, 1949. The shipments for the current month included 25,932 passenger cars, 9,610 trucks and 31 buses.
