NOVEMBER - 1950

Factory shipments of Canadianmade vehicles totalled 30,322 units in November, 1950 compared with 35,573 units in the previous month and with 19,721 units in November, 1949. The shipments for the current month included 23,420 passenger cars, 6,856 trucks and 46 buses.
