More motor cars were shipped from Canadian factories in May than in any other month since April, 1929. Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 35,281 units in May, 1950 compared with 26,386 units in the previous month and with 26,708 units in flay, 1949. The shipments for the current month included 24,648 passenger cars, 10,594 trucks and 39 buses.
