## MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

## SEPTEMBER - 1950

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 38,035 units in September, 1950 compared with 24,272 units in the previous month and with 30,894 units in September, 1949. The shipments for the current month included 27,271 passenger cars, 10,664 trucks and 100 buses.
