MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

OCTOBER - 1951

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 32,462 units in October, 1951, compared with 29,861 units in the previous month and with 35,573 units in October, 1950. The shipments for the current month included 20,470 passenger cars, 11,942 trucks and 50 buses.
