

MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

DECEMBER - 1951

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 22,086 units in December 1951, compared with 29,461 units in the previous month and with 30,738 units in December 1950. The shipments for the current month included 10,918 passenger cars, 11,126 trucks and 42 buses.
