MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

APRIL - 1951

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 41,060 units in April, 1951 compared with 47,779 units in the previous month and with 26,386 units in April, 1950. The shipments for the current month included 28,677 passenger cars, 12,343 trucks and 40 buses.
