## MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

## JUNE - 1951

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 36,229 units in June, 1951 compared with 42,911 units in the previous month and with 41,383 units in June, 1950. The shipments for the current month included 25,845 passenger cars, 10,311 trucks and 73 buses.
